Therefore, in order to fix this problem, outriggers could be extended from the deck. The outriggers make use of hydraulic pressure to be able to lift the truck slightly off of the ground, making it balanced and stable. The crawler crane is unique in that it has huge tracks on the bottom of the crane. These huge tracks are really like bulldozers and backhoes. The tracks allow the crane to successfully move around a construction site.
